Half-Life, Decay Constant, and Mean Lifetime Radioactive decay is an exponential process, meaning that the quantity of matter decreases at a rate proportional to its current value. The most intuitive mathematical description of the rate of decay is half-life, which our half-life calculator can calculate.

Those that decay are called radioactive (or parent) isotopes; those that are generated by

decay are called radiogenic (or daughter) isotopes.

The unit that we use to measure time is called half-life and it has to do with the time it takes for half of the radioactive isotopes to decay (see below).

Radioactive carbon (C-14) has a half-life of 5730 years. In spite of

this rather "short" half-life compared to the age of the earth, C-14 is a naturally occurring isotope! The reason for this is that C-14 is

formed continuously in the atmosphere when neutrons (originating from the cosmic radiation) interact with nitrogen atoms.
