26The Nyaya-Vaisesika system believes in pralaya (delusion) of the creation. At that time there remain God, all permanent substances like atoms, sky, time, space, souls, and minds and the properties in those permanent substances, universals, particulars and the permanent relation called inherence.

Language and Reality, World-View of the Nyaya-Vaisesika ...

1. It is self-subsistent with a synthetic concept of matter-hood to which all specific matters can be affiliated on account of their possession of some fundamental common character. 2. Matter-hood exists independently unlike guna/attribute or karma/action which matter.

It should, however, be observed here that the Nyaya system is in itself an elaboration of sixteen philosophical topics (padartha). These are: pramana. Prameya, samsaya, prayojana, drstanta, siddhanta, avayava, tarka nirnaya, vada, jalpa, vitanda, hetvabhasa, may be briefly explained here. Pramana is the way of knowing anything truly.

Vaisheshika or Vaiśeṣika (Sanskrit: वैशेषिक) is one of the six schools of Indian philosophy (Vedic systems) from ancient India. In its early stages, the Vaiśeṣika was an independent philosophy with its own metaphysics, epistemology, logic, ethics, and soteriology. Over time, the Vaiśeṣika system became similar in its philosophical procedures, ethical conclusions and ...

The Nyaya metaphysics recognizes sixteen padarthas or categories and includes all six (or seven) categories of the Vaisheshika in the second one of them, called prameya. These sixteen categories are 1) pramāṇa (valid means of knowledge), 2) prameya (objects of valid knowledge), 3) saṃśaya

(doubt), 4) prayojana (aim),
