The configuration for string 1 is shown in Figure 3. Equilibrium is established if $\sum F_{ix} = 0$ and $\sum F_{iy} = 0$ where the signs of the force components are taken implicitly. Using the angles shown in Figure 2, this is explicitly equivalent to: $F_1 = F_2 \cos \phi_2 + F_3 \cos \phi_3$ and $F_2 \sin \phi_2 = F_3 \sin \phi_3$.
