How to make the results of bsts robust using R?

In the bsts package, this is done by passing a prior object as created by the SpikeSlabPrior function. In this example we are specifying a prior of 0.6 on the variable called unemployment.office and forcing this variable to be selected by setting its prior spike parameter to 1. We’re giving our priors a weight of 200 (measured in observation count), which is fairly large given that the dataset has 456 records.
