The English naturalist Charles Darwin (1809-1882) had developed the Darwinism theory in biological evolution and others, stating that through the natural selection of small, inherited variations that increase the individual's ability to compete, survive, and reproduce, all species of organisms arise and develop.

Charles Darwin's theory of evolution by natural selection is the foundation upon which modern evolutionary theory is built. The theory was outlined in Darwin's seminal work On the Origin of Species, published in 1859. Although Victorian England (and the rest of the world) was slow to embrace natural selection as the mechanism that drives evolution, the concept of evolution itself gained widespread traction by the end of Darwin's life.

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Darwin's visit to the Galapagos Islands had a resounding impact on the formation of his Theory of Natural Selection. A rather unmotivated and failing medical scholar, Charles Darwin accompanied Captain Robert Fitzroy as a travel companion and naturalist on the HMS Beagle. His book the Voyage of the Beagle is an account of his worldwide journey.

Who is Charles Darwin and what his theory took from Galapagos?

Darwin's theory of evolution is based on key facts and the inferences drawn from them, which biologist Ernst Mayr summarised as follows: Every species is fertile enough that if all offspring survived to reproduce, the population would grow (fact). Despite periodic fluctuations, populations remain roughly the same size (fact).

Darwin's theory. During the survey voyage of HMS Beagle, Darwin was unaware of the significance of the birds of the Galápagos. He had learned how to preserve bird specimens from John Edmonstone while at the University of Edinburgh and had been keen on shooting, but he had no expertise in ornithology and by this stage of the voyage concentrated mainly on geology.

A good starting point for Darwin's theory was the most familiar example of how animals and plants were known to change: domestication. Darwin explained that because farmers or breeders selected individuals with particular features to breed from they thus increased the proportion of the desired features in their flocks or crops.

Charles Darwin did not come up with the Theory of Evolution on this voyage. As a matter of fact, his grandfather Erasmus Darwin had already instilled the idea that species change through time in Charles. However, the Galapagos finches helped Darwin solidify his idea of natural selection.

Charles Darwin's Finches and the Theory of Evolution

Darwin departed Britain in December and during five years aboard the Beagle he would come to begin to consider what would become known as evolutionary theory. It is possible Darwin returned to Llanymynech and continue his field work after publishing his three revolutionary - or evolutionary - books The Voyage of the Beagle, On the Origin of Species and The Descent of Man before his death in 1882.

From Llanymynech to Galapagos - the year Charles Darwin

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Charles Darwin is recognized as the Father of Evolution because of his contribution to the establishment of the idea of evolution. His theory helped in removing all the traditional old beliefs which

said that the formation of varied species was a supernatural phenomenon or act of the Almighty.
