Up to 17% of patients have a missed or delayed diagnosis of cervical spine injury, with a risk of permanent neurologic deficit after missed injury of 29%. Conditions associated with increased risk of cervical spine fracture or cord injury after trauma include ankylosing spondylitis, spinal stenosis, osteoporosis, and arthritis. Chiari malformation, os odontoideum (failed fusion at the base of the odontoid), and other conditions have been reportedly made symptomatic or aggravated by cervical spine trauma. [17]
